YOUTHWORKS SUMMER EXPERIENCE

- A paid summer work/project-based learning experience for youth ages 14-25 who live in Lawrence, Haverhill or Methuen. Youth at risk have priority.
- Participate in the program for 60-125 hours in a 6-week period.
- Receive a stipend or wage with a Bank of America Pay Card
- Incentives for completing program benchmarks.
- 15 hours of PAID mandatory job readiness workshops from the Commonwealth Corporation Signal Success curriculum.
- Typically done with a program partner who rolls out a projectbased learning experience, work experience or local companies and organizations who host youth as employees.

YOUTHWORKS YEAR ROUND

- A paid year-round work experience/internship for youth ages 14-25 who live in Lawrence, Haverhill or Methuen. Youth at risk have priority.
- Participate in the program for 125-150 hours in a 20-week period.
- Receive a stipend or wage with a Bank of America Pay Card
- Incentives for completing program benchmarks.
- 25 hours of PAID mandatory job readiness workshops from the Commonwealth Corporation Signal Success curriculum.
- Typically done with a program partner who rolls out a project-based learning experience, an internship or with a training/certification program.

YouthWorks



SIGNAL SUCCESS: WORK READINESS WORKSHOPS

- Signal Success is a curriculum designed and tested by education and workforce development partners to help young people develop essential skills for future success.
- There will be TWO sections of Signal Success totaling 15 hours: LIVE SESSIONS & SELF-PACED ONLINE
- Youth receive \$15.00 per module/live session. If youth complete all 15 hours, they'll receive an additional \$75.00.



ELIGIBILITY FOR YW SUMMER AND YWYR

YouthWorks

- ☐ Youth must be eligible to work in the United States.
- ☐ Must be income eligible (or receive free/reduced lunch).
- Must complete the online application and submit supporting eligibility documents.
- ☐ Go through information and orientation and career readiness workshops.

WORKSITES AND PARTNERSHIPS

- Host and supervise youth as a partner organization or work site: attend an orientation to learn more.
- Provide work-based learning experiences and or trainings for youth 16-25.
- Develop projects for tier 1 youth 14-15 years old (or recruit youth for existing programs). Program *support* wages available up to \$300 per youth.
- Youth stipend or wages covered at minimum wage or higher, depending.
- Contact Youth Program Manager Cristy Gomez to review your program and YW funding, develop a contract and or MOU.






